| Order | Participants | Time | Scripture |
| 1 | Jesus Christ | Third Day | “He has risen” (Matt. 28:6; cf. John 20:1-18) “The first fruits of those who have fallen asleep” (1 Cor. 15:20) |
| 2 | Church | At the Rapture; Prior to the beginning of Tribulation | in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet” (1 Cor. 15:50-51; cf. John 14:3; 1Thes. 4:13-18; |
| 3 | Old Testament saints | At the Second Coming to enter Millennial Kingdom | “you will come to life, and I will place you on your own land” (Dan. 12:1-2; cf. Isa. 26:19; Eze. 37:13-14) |
| 4 | Tribulation Martyrs | Following the Tribulation; prior to Millennial Kingdom | “came to life and reigned with Christ for a thousand years” (Rev. 20:4) |
| 5 | Millennial saints | Following the Millennium | Assumed, but not supported by Scripture |
